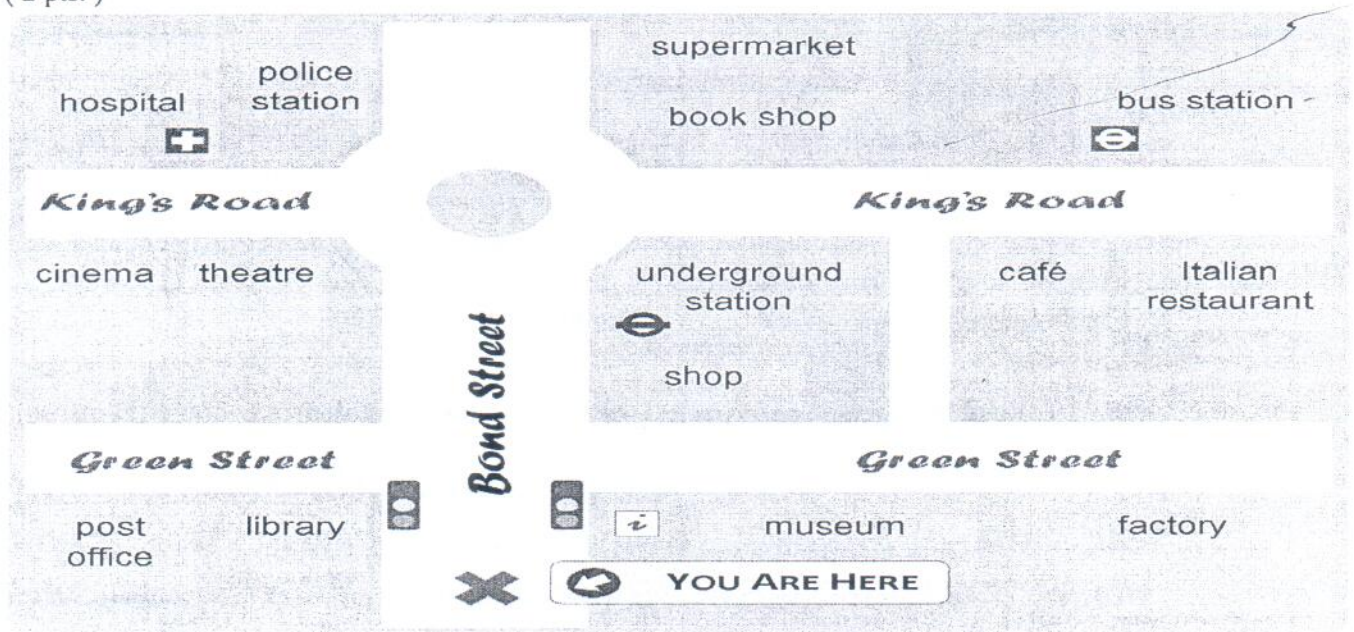

### 1 San Francisco

### 8 Disneyland
